She was attending University of Pittsburgh in Greensburg and was close to graduating with a degree in Business Management specializing in marketing and a minor in psychology. She also worked part-time at the Bean Bar in Irwin.

Deeply empathetic, she felt everything and wore her heart on her sleeve. Her goofy sense of humor and beautiful laugh made every moment with her unforgettable. 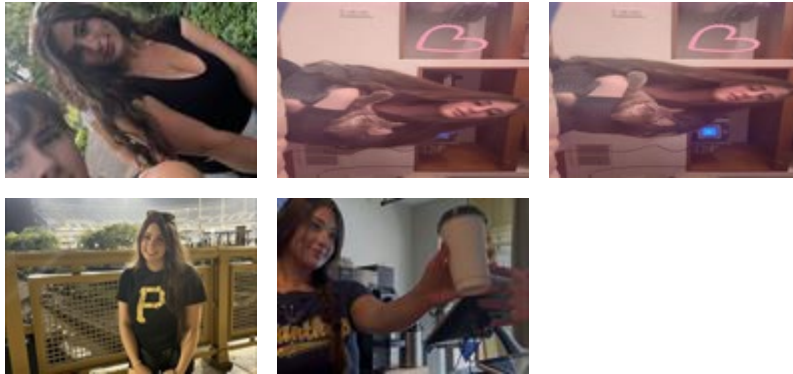

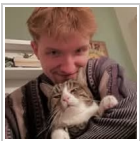
