



## Barbara A. Mitchell Langham

October 6, 1933 - July 17, 2021

Barbara A. (Mitchell) Langham, 87, of Warrenton, VA, formerly of Irwin, died Saturday July 17, 2021. 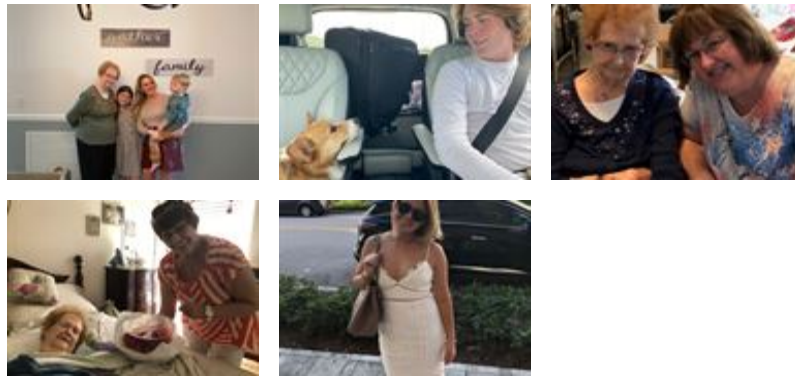
