



Carmen A. "Chief" Carulli

March 26, 1944 - January 13, 2017

Carmen A. "Chief" Carulli, 72, of North Versailles, died Friday January 13, 2017. He was born March 26, 1944 in Braddock, a son of the late Frank and Vera (Schiavo) Carulli. Carmen attended the PA Fire academy and was one of the first certified instructors of vehicle rescue tools and life saving devices in the Western PA region. He was a firefighter for fifty five years in the North Versailles Township volunteering with Green Valley VFD, Sunset Central VFD, and then the Fire Department of North Versailles. He served as chief of Green Valley VFD and Sunset Central VFD for a combined thirty years. He also had served as the Emergency Management Coordinator for North Versailles Township. Carmen was a Navy veteran and retired from employment after over 30 years with the Allegheny County Public Works Department. He was a member of St. Robert Bellarmine Church, East McKeesport, and was an animal lover. He is survived by his loving wife of 47 years Barbara A. (Bednar) Carulli; his sons Frank J. "Hole" Carulli and Anthony C. Carulli; his grandchildren whom he adored and lovingly called him "Bookah", Marchello and Faith Angelina Carulli; a sister Frances Carulli and a brother Richard (Mary) Carulli; also numerous nieces and nephews. Friends will be received from 6 to 8 p.m. Monday and 2 to 4 and 6 to 8 p.m. Tuesday at the Forgie-Snyder Funeral Home, 1032 Broadway, East McKeesport, 412-823-8083.
