Catherine L. (Fellers Derrick) Wigle, 97, of Trafford, went to be with the Lord on Saturday, Jan. 18, 2014. Catherine was born in West Virginia, Oct. 30, 1916, a daughter of the late William and Anna Locke Fellers. She was a 1935 graduate of Norwin High School and a member of St. John's United Church of Christ, Larimer.
