Daniel J. Thornburg, 60, of Greensburg, formerly of North Huntingdon, died Monday June 25, 2018. He was born August 22, 1957 in Johnstown, a son of the late Paul and Nadine (Alfred) Thornburg. Dan was a graduate of Norwin High School, Class of 1975 and was a member of the basketball, track, and cross country teams. He received "best all-around senior athlete award" his senior year. He was a member of the 1974 State Champion Cross Country Team that was recently inducted into the Norwin High School Hall of Fame. He received a bachelor's of science and education degree at Indiana University of Pennsylvania in 1982 before moving to Florida where he was a physical education instructor in Palm Springs County School District from 1986 to 1996 and was an assistant basketball coach from 1986 to 1991. He moved back to the area and was a resident of Greensburg. Danny was a big Pirates, Steelers, and Penguins fan and loved music. He is survived by his siblings, Gail (Ty) Gongaware of Ohio, Mary Deborah Thornburg of Florida, Michael Thornburg of North Huntingdon, Karen Thornburg of Florida, David Thornburg of Erie; also numerous nieces and nephews.
