Deborah "Debbie" (Yohman) Kull, 59, passed away Monday, Jan. 13, 2014, at her home in Chicago. Debbie was born July 10, 1954, in Mt. Pleasant, the daughter of Shirley and Henry Yohman, of North Huntingdon. She was a 1972 graduate of Norwin Senior High School, where she was a varsity cheerleader. At the time of her death, Debbie was vice president of Operational Excellence at the University of Chicago Medical Center. Deb was the senior executive responsible for the design, development and deployment of the UCMC performance excellence initiative. Prior to her work at UCMC, she was system director for Operational Excellence at Loyola University Medical Center in Maywood, Ill., where she led the implementation of process improvement tools to build a culture of continuous improvement at all levels of the organization. She holds a BS in business administration from Baker College and an MBA from New York Institute of Technology.
