Donald Allen Harrison, 79, of North Huntingdon, died Saturday, June 9, 2018 at home. He was born July 30, 1938 in Greensburg, a son of the late Charles and Edna (Bowser) Harrison and was also preceded in death by his daughter Kelly Ann Bollman, siblings Edith Margaret "Peggy" Wilson, Marilyn G. "Susie" Armor, James, Thomas "Tucker", and William Harrison; and a step grandson James McFadden.
