Doris Mae Stitely, 92, of Ligonier, formerly of Irwin, died Saturday December 26, 2020 from complication of the Covid virus. She was born September 30, 1928 in Irwin, the daughter of the late Arthur E. and Hannah (Bullock) Stitely. Doris was a 1946 graduate of Norwin High School then graduated from Allegheny General Hospital School of Nursing in 1949 and spent 22 years working directly with patients at Allegheny General Hospital and the University of Oregon Medical Center. She also earned a bachelor's and master's degree from the University of Pittsburgh and spent the last 22 years of her career in nursing administration. Following retirement she traveled all 50 states and around the world. She was a member of First United Methodist Church, Irwin, the Hospital Association of Pennsylvania, the American Organization of Nurse Executives, Pitt Alumni Association, and Sigma Theta Tau Honor Society. She is survived by her care giver, professional colleague, and loving friend for over 45 years Judith Daugherty-Stovall and her husband Michael also several distant second cousins including Tina Omealik and her husband Tom.
