



## Harry A. Rorabaugh

Harry A. Rorabaugh, age 73, of Irwin, died Tuesday, January 20, 2015. He was born August 16, 1941, in Wilkins Twp., a son of the late Eugene and Mabel (Winkler) Rorabaugh.
