Harry C. Walter, age 100, a lifetime resident of Manor, was called home by his Lord and Savior just 12 hours before his 101st birthday celebration on April 20, 2025. He was born April 21, 1924 in Manor, a son of the late Charles B. and Hazel (Kifer) Walter. Harry dedicated his life to family, church and the community. He attended Manor School, leaving before graduation to work and help his mother support the family. As an Army veteran of the Korean Conflict he proudly holds a Purple Heart medal.
