James Clark, 91, of North Huntingdon, died Wednesday, April 9, 2014, at Redstone Highlands, North Huntingdon. He was born July 29, 1922, in Wendel, a son of the late William and Lena (Hench) Clark. He was a retired employee of Westinghouse Electric Corporation, East Pittsburgh, with 42 years of service and was a World War II Army veteran, having reached the rank of Sergeant and received the Purple Heart medal.
