James P. Hutchins, 96, formerly of East McKeesport, died unexpectedly on Saturday, March 15, 2014, after a very brief illness. Born in Brave, Dec. 1, 1917, he was the son of the late Willis and Nellie (Throckmorton) Hutchins. Jim married the former Elma Davis on Nov. 19, 1943, in Irwin, and she preceded him in death on March 2, 2001. He was a real estate and insurance broker and owned Hutchins Agency in East McKeesport and Irwin. He was an active member of Linway United Presbyterian Church, North Versailles, and a prominent member of the East Allegheny Businessmen's Association. He also helped to create the first Real Estate Multi-List program in East McKeesport. Jim enjoyed walking, fishing, hunting big and small game and playing with his great-grandchildren. Jim moved to Green Bay, Wis., in 2006, where he was active in the Green Bay Retired Men's Club and the Men's Service Club (formerly Kiwanis) and attended First Presbyterian Church on Ashland Avenue in Green Bay. He is survived by his children, Jill Hutchins Hardy (Raymond), of Green Bay, and Dennis (Suzy) Hutchins, of Greensburg; five grandchildren, Adam (Sarah) Hardy, Lissa (Chris) Balison, John M. (Jacqueline) Hutchins, Jessica (and friend, Chuck Gould) Hutchins and Zachary Hutchins; five great-grandchildren, James Hardy, Emma Hardy, Karter Balison, Kailyn Hutchins and Hailey Hutchins; and by other friends and relatives. Jim was preceded in death by his parents; wife; grandson, Stephen Hutchins; and great-granddaughter, McKenna Hutchins.
