May 19, 1925 - October 27, 2013

John Edward "Jack" Drylie, 88, of North Huntingdon, died Sunday, Oct. 27, 2013, at Golden Heights Personal Care, Harrison City. He was born May 19, 1925, in Irwin, a son of the late David and Edna (Kistler) Drylie. He was an Army veteran of World War II, having served as a military policeman, and was the recipient of the Bronze Star. He retired after more than 33 years of service as an assistant district manager for the Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission from Irwin to the Ohio border.
