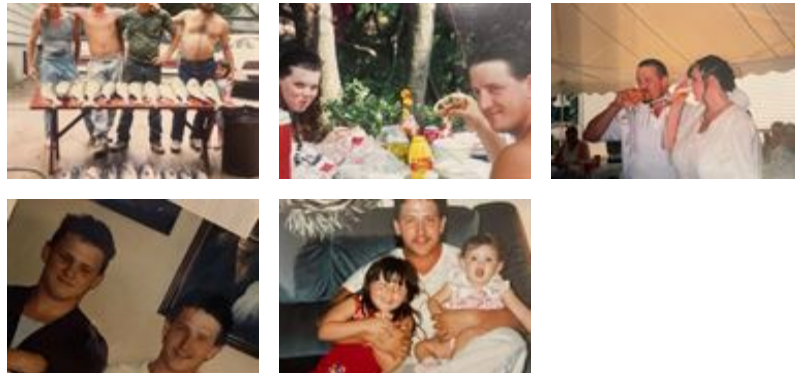
Eternal rest grant unto him, O Lord and let perpetual light shine upon him. May he rest in peace. Amen
