February 10, 1952 - February 24, 2025

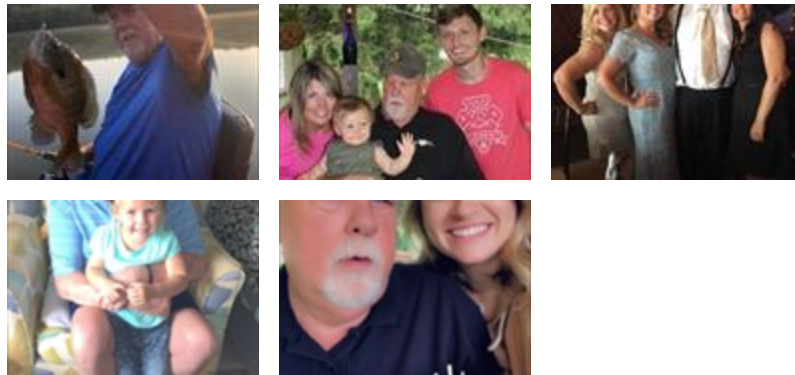
