After his two sons were born, Joe went to night school at Duquesne University where he received his degree in Accounting in 1971. Joe will always be remembered for his quick wit and smile that shone brightest when with his grandchildren and his great-grandsons. Joe worked his entire career of over 39 years at Westinghouse Electric Corp, Nuclear Division in Monroeville. He along with four coworkers invented a patent together containing radiation to a minimal level in retubing a steam generator. He served many years as a Boy Scout Scoutmaster and was an usher at Immaculate Conception in Irwin for many years before joining

St. Elizabeth Ann Seton of North Huntingdon. He served on the Norwin School District Board of Education and volunteered at a local food bank and at the Norwin Public Library after his retirement.
