



Marilyn Jane (Daugherty) Fawcett

April 10, 1936 - May 11, 2025

Marilyn Jane (Daugherty) Fawcett, 89, of Harrison City, passed away peacefully at her home on Sunday, May 11, 2025, surrounded by her precious family. She is now in the presence of her Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. Born on April 10, 1936, in North Irwin, she was the daughter of the late Clarence and Marion (Harper) Daugherty, and is preceded in death by her husband, William D. Fawcett, Sr.; toddler sister, Marcella Daugherty; brother, Clarence Daugherty (who affectionately called her “Jake”); brother-in-law, Robert (Betty) Fawcett; sister-in-law, Elizabeth Jane (Robert) Williams; and a niece, Nancy Fawcett Deslam.

A faithful Christian, her favorite verse was Nehemiah 8:10: “This day is holy to our Lord. Do not grieve, for the joy of the Lord is your strength.” Marilyn was quick to remind folks that she skipped the sixth grade; she dazzled as a majorette and subsequently graduated from North Huntingdon High School. Marilyn and Bill married in 1953. They raised five children together and co-owned the Lee-Thompson-Fawcett Co. / Bell-View Brand Food Products. She lived a full life: delivering babies and attending autopsies with Dr. Crumlish, proudly supporting her children as a Norwin Band and Athletics parent, and caring for all who entered her home. She faithfully belonged to churches, led a Koinonia group, and cherished Sheila’s Bible study and her dear friends throughout her life. Raised in the First United Methodist Church of Irwin, she then sang in the Chancel Choir and served as a deacon at the First Presbyterian Church of Irwin, ending her time as a member of the First

Evangelical Free Church in McKeesport.

Marilyn will be remembered as a wonderful and exciting woman, who lit up every room she entered with a fabulous story and exuberant laughter.

Donning her eye-catching jewelry and bright red lipstick, she was known for wearing bold prints that matched her vivacious personality. While she was quite the social butterfly, Marilyn faithfully sent cards to everyone she loved, written in her distinctive script and complete with comic strips and encouragements from Scripture. She was the consummate hostess: no one could leave her home hungry, and a “little” sugar could fix any issue, particularly in her special drink. Her grandchildren and great-grandchildren brought joy to her days with games, dippy eggs, and tea parties.

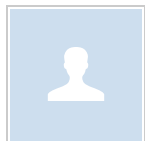
