Matilda A. "Pat" (Patosky) Altman, 90, of Irwin, died Wednesday, Aug. 13, 2014. She was born Aug. 18, 1923, in North Irwin, a daughter of the late Elmer and Frances (Scheuerle) Patosky. She was an active member of the First United Church of Christ in Irwin and retired from the Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission.
