Paul A. Schmidtke, 88, of North Huntingdon, died Thursday, July 29, 2021. He was born April 4, 1933 in Monarch, a son of the late Rudolph and Emma (Voldek) Schmidtke and was also preceded in death by siblings James R. Schmidtke, Edwina Hough, and Joana Nicolazza. Paul was a veteran of the Korean Conflict serving with the Marines and a retired supervisor for Duquesne Light with 35 years' service.
