Above all, she was a wife and mother, and superb at both.

She was a member of the former United Presbyterian Church of the Covenant, Irwin, now New Hope Presbyterian Church, North Huntingdon, and served there as Deacon.

Survivors include her three loving children Linda, Kenneth, and Tracy; her sons-in-law Don Adams, Gordon Powell, and Steve McCoy; two grandchildren, Sharon True and David Slater; ten great-grandchildren; as well as her siblings Nancy Hooper, David Lunn, and Paul Lunn.
