



## Ralph K. Triplett

October 14, 1920 - December 10, 2014

Ralph K. Triplett, 94, of North Huntingdon, died Wednesday, December 10, 2014. He was born October 14, 1920 in Wilmerding, a son of the late Walter and Mayzetta (Todd) Triplett. Ralph was a graduate of Wilmerding Memorial High School and retired in 1984 from Allegheny Power Service Corporation, Greensburg, as a senior electrical engineering technician. He was a member of Circleville United Methodist Church, North Huntingdon, a former member of St. John's United Church of Christ, Larimer, and was a longtime member of the Norwin Boosters Club where he served as vice president until the boosters club was disbanded in 1980. He was a member of the Larimer Volunteer fire Department and served as their Chaplin as well as the soloist for their funeral services. He was a life member of the V.F.W. Post 781 of Irwin, and also sang for their funeral services. Ralph was a Navy veteran of WWII serving in the Asiatic Pacific Theatre of Operations with the 28th SPNGB (Seabees). He served on the Islands of the Marshalls, Caroline's, Philippines and with the occupational forces of Japan. He was a member of the new millennium parade military committee, a charter member of the vet/2000 memorial committee and was a member of the committee for the installation of the Vietnam Veteran's Travelling Wall at Irwin Park. He did the electrical installation for the wall as well as electrical work that was necessary to make the Irwin Veterans memorial renovation project possible. He was a longtime member of the B.P.O. Elks, Norwin Lodge 2313, and a longtime member of the Jacktown Ride and Hunt Club. Besides his parents he was

preceded in death by his beloved wife of 56 years Ruth Milne Triplett in 1997; a son, Walter Triplett in 1963; two brothers, Howard and Robert Triplett; and six sisters, Edith Sadler, Ruth Kugler, Ethel Farr, Hazel Lovone Hoffman, Gwen Dugan and Irene Garbowsky. Surviving is a son, David (Lindsay) Triplett and a granddaughter, Kirby Lin Triplett all of Morgantown, WV; also several nieces and nephews. Friends will be received from 2 to 6 p.m. Saturday at the William Snyder Funeral Home, 521 Main Street, Irwin, 724-863-1200, where a funeral service will follow at 6 p.m. Private interment will be in Union Cemetery.
