Raymond R. Baston, 69, of North Huntingdon, went home to heaven on Wednesday, January 22, 2025 at home surrounded by his loving family after a brief but difficult battle with cancer. He was born as Richard Reimund on October 10, 1955, in Zweibruecken, Germany, and immigrated to the U.S. at 16 years old speaking almost no English. He moved to Export, PA, next door to a family whose youngest daughter would later become his wife. Ray was a network administrator for Mitsubishi Chemical Advanced Materials in Delmont and a member of Community United Methodist Church, Harrison City.

Throughout this life, he was an avid camper and hiker. He loved taking care of his home & property and could fix or build almost anything. Ray and his wife spent much of their life outdoors, and as empty-nesters, they took their trailer all across the country and back, camping more weekends than they were at home in the summer.
