Raymond Pallante, 94, of North Huntingdon, PA formerly of Liberty Township, Ohio, died peacefully Saturday December 16, 2023 at home surrounded by family. He was born March 13, 1929 in Youngstown, Ohio, a son of Tobio and Irene (Disabato) Pallante.
