Rich Bowen, 60, of North Huntingdon, passed away peacefully surrounded by family, Tuesday, October 8, 2024. He was born February 7, 1964, in McKeesport. Son of the late Coach Dick Bowen and Janie (Sterett) Bowen of White Oak, PA. Rich is survived by his beloved wife and soulmate of 36 years, Denise Conrad Bowen, Daughter Brittany (Zack) Ray of Trafford, Son Sean, of Youngstown, Ohio and Aaron (Juliana Boyd) of North Huntingdon. Grandchildren Kieran and Cecilia Ray and his loving and devoted sister Jodi Bowen Baldrige. Also survived by much loved cousins, in-laws, extended family, several nieces, nephews and Godsons, Matthew Tarabek and Jimmy Blaszkievicz.

Rich Bowen was a 1982 Serra Catholic graduate and multi-sport athlete, a Parade All-American Quarterback, Dapper Dan player of the year, Co-Captain Pennsylvania Big-33 all-star game and 1981 WPIAL Class A football champion among other achievements. He was a top college recruit and played for both Pitt and Youngstown State.

With an over 30-year successful career as a head football coach and athletic director, Rich worked for local high schools including Serra Catholic, Yough, Elizabeth Forward and Hempfield. He also assisted at Waynesburg University, Norwin and the latest, Greensburg Salem. In 2007, Serra won the WPIAL championship and were PIAA State runners up. Coach Bowen knew how to pull the best out of each of his players to utilize skills they didn't even know they had. His joy was to see the growth and success of each of his players, instilling in them the drive to win. Over the years Rich was privileged to work with some of the finest coaches and officials in existence and will be greatly missed.

Then there are other family members, relatives, and far too many friends and football people to mention. So please forgive me if I omitted someone. Now I want to give a special tip of the hat and acknowledge Rich's Dad, the late Coach "Dick" Bowen. Dick Bowen and my late.father, Francis "Fran" Snyder, who was active in WO politics, was very involved at St. Angelas RC Church. In addition, my Dad was a successful builder and businessman. He also operated Snyder's Turkey Farm at the Kelly St. dead end of Hill Street..He ran this from 1947 when he got out of the US NAVY following WWII to.the Fall of 1975 when his wife, my mother, Dorothy, died unexpectantly at age 56. Anyhow, I describe all this to maybe jog a memory of who my Dad was. He died at 79 after a stroke. If he were alive today, he would be 105. But I digress. My Dad and Dick were cousins. My Dad adored Dick. He followed his football career at PITT and would go to many games at Pitt Stadium. Once or twice a year, he would organize a few cars of guys from White Oak to go to Oakland for the Pitt football games. My Dad often spoke highly of Dick. He held him in high regard. One final.observation. Rich was born in Feb.1964. I first walked into McKeesport Senior High School in September 1967. I do not remember exactly when I first met Dick, but I do remember he was extremely impressive. He was a leader in the classroom and the athletic fields. So, when Rich was three and a half, I was meeting his Dad as a young high school student. My Dad followed Dick's football career. To a lesser degree I followed Rich. I went to see him at a couple of games at Serra and followed him at Pitt and beyond. Through genetics, a shared physiology, and the transfer of Gigabytes of football knowledge and a determined resolve to not only succeed, but share the knowledge and experiences. They both succeeded and now Sean and Aaron are set to carry on the family tradition.

Rich was simply the best. He loved deeply and was deeply loved. May he rest in perpetual peace.
