Robert "Bob" D. Stouffer, age 82, of Harrison City, died Thursday, May 4, 2023 at Forbes Hospital in Monroeville. He was born May 16, 1940 at the Greensburg Hospital, a son of the late John C. and Elizabeth (Ayres) Stouffer. Bob attended New Stanton Assembly of God Church. He attended Irwin High School and served two years in the U.S. Army in Stuttgart, Germany. Bob worked over 21 years at Islays in Irwin and Norwin. He retired from the PA Turnpike Commission after 30 years of service as a toll collector at the Irwin interchange. In addition to his parents, he is preceded in death by two brothers John C. and James "Jim" Stouffer. He is survived by his wife of over 55 years Linda R. (King) Stouffer; daughter Terri Sue Stouffer of Harrison City; son James "Jim" Stouffer and his wife Becky of Norvelt; and grandchildren Joshua, Nicholas and Bella Stouffer.
