Robert F. Cervi, age 89, of Irwin, passed away Sunday, September 30, 2018. He was born February 23, 1929 in Irwin, a son of the late Robert A. and Louise Marie (Mautino) Cervi. He was a long time member of Holy Trinity Lutheran Church, Irwin and will be greatly missed by the congregation. He graduated from Irwin High School in 1949 where he was a member of two state championship basketball teams and was recently honored with membership in the Norwin Athletic Hall of Fame. Bob spent his entire career working for the Borough of Irwin serving as a part-time police officer and an employee of the street department. He was a member of the Irwin Volunteer Fire Department for over 68 years where he held many positions and offices including assistant fire chief and was recognized as Fireman of the Year for 2016. In addition to his parents, he is preceded in death by his wife Sally Marie Cervi. He is survived by his brother Eugene Cervi of Maryland; and close friends Kevin and Christy Kemerer of North Huntingdon.
