Robert P. Fleming, 69, of Irwin, passed away on Monday, October 20, 2014, after a heroic battle with ALS, with his loving family by his side. Robert was born April 20, 1945 on the Southside of Pittsburgh. After graduating from Schenley High School, he joined the Air Force, and served in Vietnam. After returning home, Robert went on to have a 25-year career with Westinghouse as an engineer. He then worked at Turbine Control Service Associates prior to forming his own company, Generator Excitation Service, where he became recognized as an expert in his field, traveling throughout the world. Robert enjoyed playing the guitar, remodeling, photography, and spending time outdoors; he was also a member of the Irwin VFW 781. He was preceded in death by his mother, Dorothy J. (Patridge) Fleming; his biological mother, Louise Patridge; and his maternal grandmother, Mary "Mitzie" Patridge.
