Robert Jay Rodibaugh, 91, of North Huntingdon, passed away Monday, August 12, 2013, in Excelsa Health Westmoreland Hospital, Greensburg. Robert was born May 27, 1922, in Herminie, a son of the late Adam and Mary (Trimbath) Rodibaugh. Robert served in the Navy on the U.S.S. Caperton during World War II.
