May 19, 1917 - March 7, 2018

Rosalie "Rose" Winslow, 100, of Level Green, passed into the loving arms of her Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, on Wednesday, March 7, 2018. She was born in Niagara Falls, NY, on May 19, 1917, and was the daughter of the late Sarah Malia Cutia and the late Joseph Catanese of Bovard. Rose was a homemaker and mother who was famous for her beautiful smile, red hair, and her apple pies. She was a devout Christian who shared the message of salvation through Christ to everyone she met, and was a member of the Christian Life Church in Trafford.
