With deep sorrow, we announce the passing of our beloved mother, grandmother, and great-grandmother, whose life was a testament of devotion, faith, and tireless effort.

Stella Astley, 99, of Irwin, went to be with the Lord March 30, 2025 peacefully at home and in the loving care of her family. She was born January 21, 1926 in Trafford, a daughter of the late Harry and Anastasia (Povelko) Tereletsky. In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband William E. Astley and siblings Mary Barnyk, Sophie Pulkownik, and Harry, Michael, and Nicholas Tereletsky. She is survived by her loving children William S. Astley (Susanne) of Plattsmouth, NE, James G. Astley (Betsy) of Pittsburgh, Linda D. Lakdawala (Robert Baudoux) of Oakmont, Jeffrey D. Astley (Carol) of Harrison City, Edward A. Astley of Carnegie, Kevin R. Her love and commitment extended beyond her family, as she was a devout Catholic who found solace and purpose in her faith.

Following the heartbreaking loss of her dear husband Bill in 1990, she embraced a new calling that would touch countless lives around the world. She dedicated herself to hand making and donating an astounding 94,867 sets of rosary beads, filling the void left by Bill's passing with a mission of love and compassion. Her devotion to this cause was unwavering, and it became a

cornerstone of her life's work.

Her contributions to the community were profound. She was honored to be a faithful member at Immaculate Conception Church in Irwin, where she served as a Eucharistic Minister, CCD instructor, and Lecter at both funerals and masses. Her voice graced the funeral choir, and she actively participated in the Christian Mothers group, embodying the spirit of service and faith.

Prior to transitioning to a homemaker, Stella worked at Westinghouse airbrake supporting the war effort during World War II. Her impact extended to the family's rental properties, where she played a pivotal role in managing the business. Doing this while raising seven children was no easy task. Her strength and determination were evident in her often humorous threats of "a good swift kick" to keep them in line.

Her love for gardening was a constant throughout her life. She spent countless hours tending to the family garden when her children were young, and later, she turned her attention to her beautiful flowers as her kids left the roost. Her passion for crafts was equally remarkable; she handmade Christmas ornaments, crocheted dozens of afghans and hand knitted christening outfits for her grandchildren with loving care.

Her legacy is one of boundless love, unwavering faith, and dedicated service. Her memory will forever be cherished by her family, friends, and all whose lives she touched.
