Timothy John Sturgeon, 55, passed away on Monday, June 1, 2026, at his home in North Irwin, PA.

Born on May 11, 1971, in Pittsburgh, PA, Timothy was survived by his loving family: his parents, Stephen R. and Beverly Jane (Allen) Sturgeon; his daughters, Brianne Elizabeth (Tyler) Nelson and Brenna Morgan Sturgeon, and their mother Shannon Lee Sturgeon; and his sister, Jennifer Mae Sturgeon.

After graduating from Franklin Regional High School in Murrysville, PA (1989), Tim attended The Pennsylvania State University, graduating with a Bachelor of Science in Molecular and Cell Biology (1993). He went on to work as a Cytometry Specialist for the Center of Vaccine Research and was the Cytometry Core Manager for the University of Pittsburgh. An esteemed scholar, he co-authored numerous peer-reviewed articles, such as virology publications in the scientific journal, Elsevier. As a Research Specialist III, he also conducted HIV and cancer research at the University of Pittsburgh where he worked for 28 years.

He loved fishing with his daughters, whether at a local pond or surf/pier fishing in the Outer Banks; enjoyed coaching both girls' soccer and basketball teams; had fun bowling and attending Pirates games with his daughters; loved

cooking amazing meals for his family, and spent time hunting, golfing, and playing the trumpet. He loved his family, his many pets, and watching Penn State and Steelers football.
