July 24, 1917 - October 26, 2013

Virginia T. Beswick, 96, of North Versailles, passed away Saturday, Oct. 26, 2013, at the Cedars of Monroeville. Virginia was born July 24, 1917, in East McKeesport, a daughter of the late Harry A. and Evelyn M. (Moore) Thompson. She graduated with her associate's degree from Grove City College. Virginia was the last living charter member of Linway United Presbyterian Church, North Versailles, where she served as a Sunday school teacher and a bible school and prayer circle leader. She was a member of the founding committee for Meals on Wheels in 1971, where she continued to volunteer through 2012, and was a Girl Scout leader. Virginia was preceded in death by her husband, Charles L. Beswick Sr.; a son, Thomas G. Beswick; and a sister, Ruth Stark. She is survived by her children, Charles L. Beswick Jr. and his wife, Judith, of Sewickley, Kathryn B. Schultz and her husband, John C., of Murrysville, and daughter-in-law, Mary Beswick of North Versailles; six grandchildren; and 14 great-grandchildren. A funeral service will be held at 10 a.m. Tuesday, in Christ Lutheran Church, 5330 Logan Ferry Road, Murrysville, with Pastor Wayne Gillespie officiating.
