



## W. Paul Spencer

May 17, 1919 - August 1, 2014

W. Paul Spencer, 95, of Pittsburgh, died Friday August 1, 2014 in UPMC Magee Hospital. He was born May 17, 1919 in Irwin, a son of the late William T. and Myrtle Mae (Slaughenhou) Spencer and was also preceded in death by a brother Jack M. (and his wife Lois) Spencer. Paul retired as vice president of purchasing for Eastern Gas & Fuel Associates after forty years' service with the company. He was a graduate of Norwin High School, Class of 1937 and proudly served 4 years in the Army Air Force during WWII, with the 50th Air Service Squadron. Paul was a master gardener, awarded Life Member in the Western Pennsylvania Orchid Society, was an active volunteer at Phipps Garden Center and was Trustee Emeritus of Phipps Conservatory and Botanical Garden Center. He was a volunteer at the Animal Rescue League and a dedicated member of St. Andrew Lutheran Church, Pittsburgh. Paul is survived by many dear friends and will be greatly missed. At Paul's request there will be no viewing. A graveside service with military honors will be held at Union Cemetery, North Huntingdon. A memorial service will be held at 11 a.m. September 13, 2014 at St. Andrew Lutheran Church, 304 Morewood Ave., Pittsburgh, PA 15213.
