William J. Raynak, 82, of Mt. Juliet TN, formerly of Irwin, died Tuesday, February 13, 2024. He was born January 10, 1942 in Claridge, a son of the late John and Susanna (Gaydak) Raynak and was also preceded in death by siblings John Raynak, Mary Dobernick, and Margaret Heid. Bill retired as circulation manager for the Tribune Review and had a 41 year career in newspapers that included the Milton Standard, the Jeannette News Dispatch and the Pittsburgh Press and Post-Gazette. He was a former member of Holy Trinity Lutheran Church, Jeannette, and attended St. Stephens Roman Catholic Church, Old Hickory, TN. He was the youngest member when he joined and was past president of the Jeannette Lions Club. Bill was a Navy veteran who served during the Cuban Missile Crisis aboard the USS Intrepid. He loved music, played in the Navy band, and also was known as the “night watchman” as a DJ on the ship. He is survived by Joanne S. Raynak; his sons David J. Raynak (Saundra) of Mt. Juliet, TN and Jonathan S. Raynak (Stacey) of Freedom; his grandchildren Matthew, Kayla, and Cameron Raynak; also nieces and nephews. Friends will be received from 2 to 4 and 6 to 8 p.m. Sunday, February 18, at the William Snyder Funeral Home, 521 Main St., Irwin, 724-863-1200, where a funeral service will be held at 10 a.m. Monday. 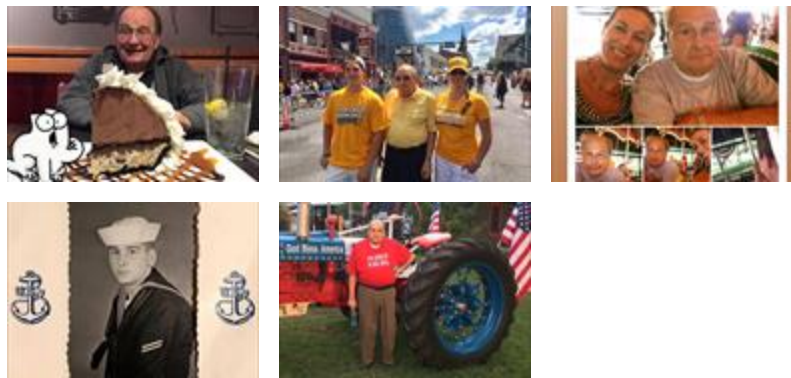
