William Frederick Wahl Jr., born on February 13, 1930 in Philadelphia, passed away on September 20, 2016 at 86 years of age. He loved to fish in the Ten Thousand Islands and to swim in the Gulf of Mexico. Bill made a friend wherever he went.
